

D&T NDP Steering Group meeting

24th Feb 2021-02-28

Tracey Kitto chaired the meeting

1. Mhairi gave an **update to the Reg 14 Public Consultation** – 113 paper copies and 43 online =156 in total. Jeff has started the analysis which should be complete in two weeks time.
2. **Statutory bodies responses** – about 10 in total.
 - Agreed that the points raised by Natural England about the wording of policies relating to ‘settlement boundaries’ or ‘development boundaries’ being interchangeable should be checked with Sarah Furley CC
 - Agreed that response from Natural England, Highways England and Devon and Cornwall Constabulary should be noted and draft policies amended accordingly.
 - Responses to Cornwall Council will need further detailed discussion at next meeting, but will need revisiting of the % of affordable housing and further work on the Greenspace documentation.
 - Points raised by Natural England about the landscape - Mhairi agreed to send them a copy of the Landscape Character statement.
 - Response from National Grid was accepted and should be added to the Evidence base.

Overall it was agreed that the responses from public body consultation should be considered at the same time as the Steering group looks at the results of the Public Consultation Survey.

It was noted that Liskeard Town Council has been given confirmation and copies of maps showing that the Moorswater and Lodge hill changes in parish boundaries. It was confirmed that these changes would not alter the coverage of the D&T NDP which would remain effective (when made) in the current (Pre May2021) parish boundaries.

3. NDP Equalities Impact assessment – some minor amendments agreed.
The group also agreed the proposed Document Management system developed by Sean, and that new documents saved for online access should be saved as PDF/A documents to comply with disability legislation.

4. Timetable for the REg15 NDP submission - Mhairi proposed a two week extension to the preparation period to accommodate the completion of the Open Space Strategy. Hugh said that it was important that any modification of the timeline should not affect the agreed date for submission, even if the strategy is incomplete.

It was agreed that the group should spend the next two weeks focusing on the Greenspace issues to allow as much of this work to be completed by the time the Survey results are available. Mhairi agreed to pull this information together and circulate to allow a Zoom meeting to discuss how to proceed.
