Brian, Sean, Michael and Mhairi had met with Robert Lacey, Ben Curnow and Jane Pascoe by Zoom earlier in the afternoon and raised the questions which had been raised by steering group members. Although neither Robert nor Ben could give assurances, they agreed that they thought it was very unlikely that an Independent Examiner would insist on changes to the D&T NDP boundary if, as part of the Basic Conditions Statement:

- a) We included letters from each of the affected councils (Liskeard Town Council, St Keyne and Trewidland Parish Council and Dobwalls Parish Council) making it clear that they understood the implications of the Boundary changes on the D&T NDP and on them.
- b) Robert and Ben would come up with a form of wards which they felt would clarify the issues and which could form the basis of these responses
- c) Robert would also write a letter from CC Planning to be included in the Basic Conditions document which drew attention to the extended discussions which had taken place regarding the boundary changes, and supported the continuation of the original D&T designated boundaries as the most appropriate solution.

2. Update on Reg14 additional consultation

MM reported that only one consultee so far had made contact, but that she would be sending out a second email to all additional consultees on Tuesday 31st May to remind them that their input was requested. Draft emails to be approved at the 30th May NDP Steering group meeting.

3. Update on Landowners information / email

Both MM and TK had been developing lists of landowners and maps for the three main settlements, and TK has saved her versions to onedrive so that MM can edit and a final format and letter can be agreed at the 30th May Steering group meeting. It was agreed that these letters would be posted.

4. Onedrive tidy up

Thanks to Sean all non current versions of key documents are now in folders on onedrive.

There were several questions that steering group members wanted to raise to ensure that any work we are now doing is not wasted. Action: MM to email RL and JP to check on their availability for such a meeting and report back.

2. Report to ST Keyne and Trewidland Parish meeting 11th May 22

MM made a verbal report to St K&T PC meeting, but also sent a short report to the PC Chair, and to Jane Pascoe (previously circulated). This made those attending aware of the current issues raise by CC to the boundary changes, but no issues were raised suggesting that agreement to these changes were going to be a problem for the PC. Armand Thoms (CC ward councillor for Trewidland) had been present at the meeting and had made clear that he was happy to assist the D&T NDP in any way he could.

There was some concern from Steering group members about the raising of the Trewidland Green infrastructure Strategy, and circulation of the Trewidland edited version of the strategy to the PC and to local people who have responsibilities relating to Public Rights of way at this stage. MM agreed that she should have checked this with Steering group members in advance but explained that she was hoping to fill in gaps in the GIS which were the result of the Covid emergency and difficulty of completing local PRoW information for the Trewidland area. It was noted that the version sent out was not based on the most up to date version of the GI Strategy document.

SJ agreed to edit the StK&T parish report for forwarding to the Dobwalls PC before their next meeting.

3. **Update on Reg 14 additional Consultation** 16 May-27 June 2022

MM reported that the emails and Reg 14 document had been sent out to the 20 additional consultees agreed on 15th May 22. A record is being kept of the receipt of this email, and of responses .

4. Review of Evidence base documents:

The remainder of the meeting focussed on the Community Health EB edits, including the lack of corespondence between reference numbers in the text and the sources list at the end of the document. The meeting was held to update everyone on the progress of final proofreading and editing of all the D&T NDP submission documents for the Reg 15 Submission to Cornwall Council. All the most up to date documents had been uploaded to the Onedrive shared drive set up by Sean.

Basic Conditions Statement document:

Sean had gone through this and requested better copies of the CC SEA response documents for inclusion in the Appendix. It was agreed that this letter was not included in any other document.

It was also agreed that the Equalities Impact Assessment should only be included in this BCS document and not appear elsewhere else.

In principle it was agreed that all supplementary information should only be located in one place: e.g. Development Boundaries Analysis document should appear only in Housing Evidence Base, and should not be listed as a separate document.

Ailsa was not able to attend the meeting to report, but has subsequently confirmed that she is working on the Consultation documents.

Landscape Character Statement:

Tracey had had a lot of trouble with the 'publisher' format of the LCS document, and had had to print a copy, mark it up and scan her printed notes. These were now on the OneDrive system.

There was some discussion on whether the 1st of December version of the LCS document was based on the 7th January 2021 agreed Reg14 LCS document. MM agreed to check this (it was, although there are additional sections and some minor changes to text in the Dec2021 version.) Several of the Policy code numbers have changes since the Reg 14 submission, and these have not all been picked up in the document, but Tracey has checked these now.

MM has now created an updated document picking up Tracey's edits, and removing much of the Development boundaries detail (referring to the full Development Boundaries Analysis now in the Housing Evidence Base for more detail); and checking and standardising the list of policy references on page 4 and in the Planning and Management Guidelines sections. (If John Dunn could print this 6th January 2022 version and let Tracey have the hard copy to check again, it would avoid all the problems that we had with the previous publisher document.


