The event is just one element of a day of Jubilee celebrations which also involves Dobwalls Football Club.

Everyone's welcome and those who can't walk to the field can park their cars at the football club.

IT COULD TAKE 1,000 YEARS



ONE of the trees planted in the parish's Jubilee community space is in memory of Terence Frisby, the wartime evacuee with his brother Jack, who spent three years at 7 Railway Cottages, Doublebois, with a Welsh couple known to everyone as Uncle Jack and Auntie Rose.

Terence, a famous playwright, producer and actor, recaptured those years in his book "Kisses on a Postcard". His story featured in the Spring edition of "The Villager".



PARISH CLERK LINDA COLES

Family and friends gathered to celebrate the planting of "Terry's Tree" and Dobwalls Parish Council clerk Linda Coles explained that the seedling was grown from an acorn which came from the famous Darley Oak Tree at Darley Farm in the parish of Linkinhorne on the edge of Bodmin Moor. It's believed to be at least 1,000 years old—the oldest oak tree in Cornwall. It's registered as tree number 12217 on the Ancient

Tree Inventory and celebrated as one of the 50 Great British Trees. Beth Plummer, who lives in Dobwalls, told Terence's family

and friends lots of stories about her late husband Ken who knew Terence well and talked a lot about "my little pal Terry". Beth says Terence sent her a Christmas card every year and she's kept them.

Terence Frisby died in 2020, but, through the generations of his family and friends, his memory will live on for centuries in this, at present, modest tree, as it grows to, like Terry, great heights!



"The first one is called the 'Great Treburgie Farm Loop' - and the footbridge has recently been repaired. We are open to suggestions for future routes and would like to see any photographs you have taken while walking the local area. Happy rambling and remember the Country Code!"



Route 1 – Great Treburgie Farm Loop


Distance – 2 miles/3.25 km approx

Time – 1.00 to 1.5 hours

Difficulty – Moderate, due to the steepness of the hills to and from the footbridge

Sean writes: From the Highwayman Pub go to Rowes Garage/Five Lanes and turn left down Beneathway. Go all the way down and under the railway bridge to the gate on the left. Go through the gate and south west downhill towards the new footbridge crossing the river. The footbridge is out




of sight, so aim slightly left, with the power pole as a marker. Please take


care, as you are now entering working farmland—and keep an eye open, as a fox has been spotted in the valley.

After crossing the bridge continue south east up the hill to

the first gate, after that you will see another gate which takes you south west towards Treburgie Farm.









And, please take care crossing the major road.

Take the bridleway from Treburgie Water back to the Twelvewoods roundabout. A fox has been seen

crossing the path near the railway bridge. I wonder if it's the same one mentioned earlier?

Once you reach the roundabout,

you're almost there. Head back to the Highwayman for some well deserved post-walk refreshments. Other beverages and soft drinks are available, but mine's a pint!

THE BATS OF BLACKWATER FARM

LISA and Philip Evans moved to Blackwater Farm, Dobwalls, in 2013 and while exploring their fields discovered a row of ancient Oak trees in the valley. The trees had small, numbered boxes attached to them, each with a slit in them.

"We assumed the boxes are for bats," says Lisa. "They are consecutively numbered from 70 to 80, so we know there are many more on the trees in the fields on either side of our land.

"We were visited by a bat conservation team and were told bats had been filmed using the two mesh, bat bridges across the bypass, which imitate the tree line and allow the bats to safely cross the dual carriageway into our bottom field, so we knew the bats were around."

Last Autumn a bat inspection took place and Lisa spent the day with ecologist Grace England and her team: "I was fascinated to watch an abandoned hornet's nest uncovered in one box and birds' eggs in another. Then we found two sparkly eyed Pipistrelle's.

"What a wonderful sight!"





Lisa adds that bats, although a protected species, have a bad press, between possible links to Covid and associations with vampires, but they have huge appetites and eat the insects from the farm dung pile!

"Up close they are mythical, with wicked insectcrunching teeth and leathery wings with clawed fingers on the ends.

"I know I'm not selling them to you, but what a fantastically

adapted mammal the bat is, and we will happily continue to protect them on our land while they roost in the gloom of the valley."

WITH a lifetime of being overweight, Chrissie Ham finally beat the emotional and physical burden of her excess stones and pounds.






Council vice-chairman Tracey Kitto, who organised the litter pick, says:
